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# What Does the Marin County Commission on Aging Do? **Answer: Information and Advocacy**

arin County has one of the fastest growing older adult populations in California. In 2024, more than 30% of Marin's population is over 60 years old compared to 20% statewide. It will increase to 40% within the next 10 years.

The Marin County Commission on Aging is federally mandated by the Older Americans Act as an advisory council to the Marin County Board of Supervisors and the Area Agency on Aging, part of Marin's Aging and Adult Services.

The Marin County Commission on Aging:

- Promotes the dignity, independence and quality of life of older persons through advocacy, information and related programs.
- Educates and informs older adults in areas that may impact their welfare including housing, health care, nutrition, transportation, financial security and related legislation.
- Encourages an understanding of ageism and

ableism in the community by focusing on respect and collaboration for all.

- Provides a forum for public feedback and involvement.
- Raises awareness on aging topics and issues through community education.
- Consults with special groups that have responsibilities related to the over-60 popu-

Commissioners represent their respective cities, towns and districts and are appointed to three-year terms by either the Board of Supervisors or their City or Town Councils.

The public is encouraged to get involved and attend the general and committee meetings and participate in discussions dealing with issues impacting older adults.


# Marin's Legal Lifeline: Serving the Underserved Since 1958

Since 1958, Legal Aid of Marin (LAM) has served as the pre-eminent no-cost civil ■ legal services provider for low-income and otherwise marginalized Marin community members. LAM's service areas include: recovering wages for immigrant workers, primarily through wage claims; advocating for tenants' rights and enforcing renter protections; and providing housing legal services in eviction defense, homelessness prevention, housing stability, and habitability cases. We also represent individuals in consumer protection matters, connect seniors with estate planning services, eliminate fines and help restore driver's licenses through the Marin Community Court and Driver's License Workshop programs, and increase access to pro bono legal services through partnerships with the private bar.

In 2023, LAM closed 1,303 client cases. Our

in-house legal services directly impacted an estimated 3,280 individuals. Staff conducted 200 outreach events across Marin County reaching anestimated additional 2,600 attendees.

We partner with trusted community-based social services organizations to ensure that the communities we serve have meaningful access to critical safety net services. LAM is committed to increasing access to justice for many communities, including seniors, who comprise approximately 30% of our client base. As attorneys and advocates, we focus on educating Marin residents on their rights, representing clients facing life-defining legal matters, and changing laws to ensure that equity is not just an ideal but a reality for everyone who calls Marin home. LAM is proud to serve Marin County and is grateful to participate in the Marin Senior Fair.
